

WHY CHOOSE PROPANE

- » Propane is the environmental choice, it is non-toxic, does not pollute the water supply and is not a greenhouse gas.
- » Propane water heaters produce 2.5 **times the amount of hot water** compared to electric models.
- » Propane furnaces are 20-30% more efficient than comparable fuel oil models.
- » The average propane furnace lifespan is 40% longer than electric heat pumps.
- » Propane water heaters cost approximately 30% less to operate than electric models.

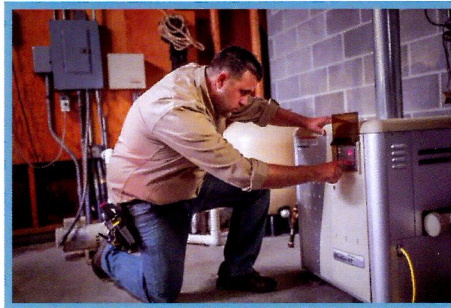

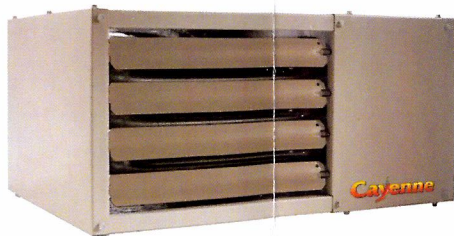

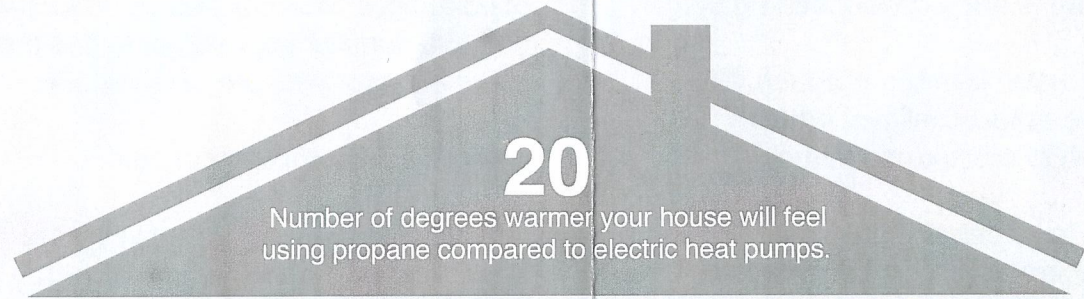
